It's Time to File for City Elections

With the May 13th election three months away the city has begun accepting ballot applications. This year we will be voting for our Mayor and two Alderman (City Council) positions.

Candidate information and application packets are available at City Hall for those interested in seeking office. The deadline to file for a place on the ballot is March 13th at 5:00 P.M. Any adult citizen of Shoreacres who has resided in the city for at least six (6) months by Election Day is eligible to run for the office of Alderman.
