Trash Collection & Water Rates Increase

Increased energy expenses (fuel & electricity) have had a direct impact on the City's utility operating expenses. The costs have increased despite expenditure reductions these departments have achieved in other areas.

Trash collection, water and sewer are services paid for by service charges and not by your property taxes.

Trash collection costs to the City have increased \$1.35 per month. The increased cost must be passed through to residents resulting in an increase of the monthly charge from \$12.00 to \$13.35.

Water costs have also increased during the last year making is necessary to raise the rates charged for water. No change in the sewer rates has been required.

The increased water rates are now in effect and are reflected effective the December billing (for November consumption).
