### Bayport Terminal Community Meeting

In response to our request, representatives of the Port of Houston Authority will participate in a follow-up meeting with you to address your concerns about the Bayport Container Terminal operations in an open forum.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 20, from 6:30pm until 8:00pm at the Sylvan Beach Pavilion.

The purpose of the meeting is to give you an opportunity to voice your concerns, ask questions and provide input on resolutions related to the terminal operation issues.

To allow the maximum number of residents the opportunity to address port representatives, residents will be asked to sign up to speak and will be limited to three minutes for comments, questions and proposed solutions. Questions and comments may be submitted in writing that evening or mailed directly to the Port of Houston Authority.

#### CALL 24- HOURS FOR:

- Emergency information about industrial facility incidents or transportation incidents involving a rail car, tanker truck, pipeline, or marine vessel that may require public protective action.
- Information about emergency response actions, explosions, fires, or chemical releases that may require public protective action.
- Information when community or industry warning alarms sound.
- General information about flaring, smoke, noise, nuisance odors, drills, firefighting training or minor incidents that may not require protective action.
- Shelter-in-place instructions.
- Odor reporting.
