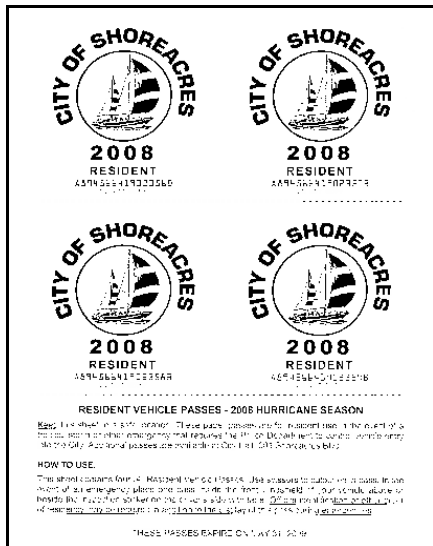

2008 Hurricane Season & Vehicle Passes

The 2008 hurricane season officially begins on the first day of June and ends on the last day of November. Experts predict another active season with an extended forecast that includes fifteen named storms, eight hurricanes, and a 44% chance that at least one major storm will strike the Gulf Coast of the United States.



In preparation the City has circulated Resident Vehicle Passes with the May utility bills. These paper passes are for use whenever traffic into Shoreacres is controlled during an emergency (storm, chemical release, etc.). Additional passes are available at City Hall during normal office hours. Instructions for use are on the pass sheet.
