Estimated Utility Bill

As a result this month your water consumption has been estimated by the billing system (using a four-month average). We expect that this bill will be higher than actual use. We will adjust the water consumption to an accurate amount as soon as we are able to read meters.

Inquire about the status of applications for federal assistance.

Disaster assistance may include grants to help pay for temporary housing, home repair and other serious disaster-related expenses not covered by insurance or other sources. Low-interest disaster loans from the SBA also are available for residential and business losses not covered by insurance or other sources.
