This month's tip is "Burglary of a Motor Vehicle". We have had some bmv's in the past month in the city. In Shoreacres the suspect will not break the glass or even pop the lock of a motor vehicle to get inside. They do not have to. They burglarize vehicles that are unlocked. Citizens leave all kinds of expensive property inside their vehicles at night and leave them unlocked. You can not leave a digital camera, a laptop computer or other item in your vehicle over night and expect it to be there in the morning. Use your alarm system on your vehicle. No they do not work in the shopping center parking lots. Too many cars and not enough patrol. They do work in your drive way or even the street. If you must leave items in your vehicle I would suggest that you at least have the serial number so we can list them in the N.C.I.C. national computer. That way if they are pawned we will be able to get them back and maybe have a lead on a possible suspect.

The new Dodge Charger patrol vehicles are now fully equipped and on patrol duty. We have had several commits on them. They are equipped with state of the art police equipment. We hope to get twenty miles to the gallon. They also are very roomy inside and handle well with rear wheel drive.

Attached are the monthly stats for the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement and the month to month stats for the city. Thirty four cases reported and thirty two closed for a 94% case clearance rate. Not bad!
