I would now like to talk about the increase in truck traffic on State Highway 146. They are slowly shifting companies from the Barbers Cut terminal to Bayport to ease the overcrowding. When you are waiting to cross and get on Highway 146 from Shoreacres Blvd. at Choate Road be sure to look both ways before entering the roadway even though you have a green light. I again would like to inform everyone that the right shoulder on Shoreacres Blvd. at Highway 146 is marked with a solid white line. You can not legally cross that line to drive on the shoulder to make a right turn. Now that the traffic lights are working properly citations may be issued.
