As of today we will have a hurricane in the Gulf that looks like it might come this way. I have received several questions about highways being blocked and certain routes to take. The new hurricane evacuation plan is pretty simple. Evacuation is to be done by zones. Each zone contains several zip code numbers. We are in zone "B". You can go in any direction you want. If you get off the freeway you can get back on at any time. The only restriction is when you get outside the city limits of Houston. If controflow lanes are set up then and only then will you be restricted. If we have a major hurricane in our area the return back to our city may be restricted. You should have a blue City of Shoreacres paper decal. You will need to show that decal. This is not to say if you have a drivers license are other type if I.D. you may be permitted in. Any special needs people will need to call city hall in advance. Special needs also includes," I do not have transportation." The city web sight will be updated before and after any possible storm. It will contain usefully information. The phone lines will probably be down so that is a good way to obtain information before and after a storm. If the city receives a mandatory evacuation from the Governor you will receive notice by emergency 911 call down system. If you do not leave when suggested there will be no one here to help you later if you need help. Any one having any questions should contact Chief R. J. French at City Hall.

In lighter news, the school opening went very well. I would like to thank people for not blocking Byway and Westview. The traffic moved very well for the first busy week. We will have a police officer in the school zone as permitted every morning and afternoon.
