Again the police report will be a little different this month. As of November 1, 2008, the police department has gone back to their normal shifts. The Commercial Vehicle Inspection unit has started back up. As shown on the monthly comparison sheet the suspicious person/vehicle calls are still high. The traffic (sight seers and others) has dropped off considerable. The total calls for service have remained high. I have received a letter of resignation from Officer C. Tanner. I have received some applications for full time and part time officers and started the background investigations on both.
