
The Shoreacres Police Department has crested a list for swimming pool violations, which included no fence and dirty pool water. Letters were sent out on these violations and after the required time citations were sent out. A list for junk vehicles was also created and letters were sent to the owners informing them what needed to be done with the vehicles. That list will be checked again and those not in compliance will also receive a citation. A third list was created pertaining to junk in yards and high grass or weeds. Those residences in violation were sent a letter on April 2, 2009. That list will be checked at a later time to see who has come into compliance. Monday yet another list will be produced in relation to demolition debris. This list is separate from junk in yards because more time was given to citizens who piled debris between the street and ditch thinking the city was going to pick it up. There will be about sixty homes on this list. In the letters sent out the citizen was advised they have ten days to comply. Any citizen can call City Hall and request more time are inform us that the problem has been taken care of. Those who comply with the request are request more time will not receive a citation. If we do not hear from you and nothing was done to clear up the violation you will receive a citation. Each location is again checked before sending out any citation.

September 1, 2009 is the deadline for the forty hour required training each police officer must maintain in the State of Texas. Officers of the Shoreacres Police Department will be in compliance with that deadline next month.

I have received many questions about the school zones on Fairfield and Old Highway 146. People have been asking is the school zone still in effect. We were enforcing the

school zone when the children were still being dismissed from Bayshore Elementary but that is no longer the case. The school zone is not in effect even though the school zone light is flashing at the listed times. Those school zone signs will be removed after the new school is opened on McCabe Street.
