The suspect was involved in the recent wreck where he cross the centerline and killed two people. He went to the hospital for treatment and then walked off. He was arrested and returned to Galveston County.

This month Tx. DOT gave a presentation at the Houston Yacht Club to review the plans for the highway 146 updates. During this meeting they explained the plans for the overpass at Wharton Whelms, Shoreacres Blvd. Choate Road and Port Road overpasses. Alternate lanes will be made and at no time will north or south bound traffic down to only one lane. The lanes will be narrow in width and have a cement retaining wall on the sides but traffic should be able to move without to much of a problem.

The cold weather will be upon us this week and drivers are advised to use caution while driving. Slow down and leave extra room between yourself and the vehicle in front of you. Even if someone pulls between you and the other vehicle. If you start to slide on ice do not hit your breaks. Drivers should start to break earlier when they know they are going to have to stop up the road. Apply your breaks sooner and slower.

The parking lot and the new roof for City Hall have been completed along with the new stairway entrance. Work on the downstairs will hopefully start soon. One of the 2007 Dodge patrol vehicle was sold at auction and the new 2010 patrol vehicle is now being rigged and will be on patrol soon.
