

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-04

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF BOATS STORED ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF SHOREACRES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, TEXAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, occupant, or person in charge of property zoned for single-family residential use to permit the storing of a boat with an overall length greater than twelve feet (12') unless the boat is wholly enclosed within a garage or securely placed on a boat trailer that can be used to legally transport the boat on a public highway.

Section 2. Boats on trailers may be parked on residential premises of the owner provided that: (a) the boat and trailer are parked or stored wholly within the owner's property line; (b) the trailer is in a good state of repair and maintained in such condition as not to be unsightly; (c) grass and weeds are maintained in a neat and orderly fashion beneath the trailer, not to exceed six (6) inches in height; and (d) the boat and trailer are parked or stored in a safe manner, so as to protect the health and safety of all persons.

Section 3. Violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10) nor more than one-hundred dollars (\$100) for each day said violation exists.
