

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-65

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHOREACRES AND THE HARRIS COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, FOR THE COORDINATION OF WATERSHED AND STREAM HYDRAULIC MODELING; TECHNICAL REVIEW AND COMMENT ON REQUESTS FOR CONDITIONAL LETTERS OF MAP REVISIONS, LETTER OF MAP REVISIONS, and PHYSICAL MAP REVISIONS; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES:


Section 1. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the Memorandum of Understanding, or other undertaking described in the title of this ordinance, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Secretary. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all related documents on behalf of the City of Shoreacres to confirm acceptance by the City of Shoreacres. The City Secretary is hereby authorized to attest to all such signatures and to affix the seal of the City to all such documents.

Section 2. The City Council officially finds, determines, recites, and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ordinance and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval, and it is so ordered.
