## CANVASS OF VOTES OF MAY 9, 2009 SALES TAX ELECTION

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY SALES TAX ELECTION HELD ON MAY 9, 2009.

There came to be considered the returns of the election on May 9, 2009 for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition to determine whether to adopt a one-quarter (1/4) of one percent (1%) sales and use tax for street maintenance, and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at the City of Shoreacres General Election, 172 valid and legal ballots: and that FOR and AGAINST in the election received the following votes:

FOR AGAINST 110 votes 57 votes

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, STATE OF TEXAS:

THAT, said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given accordance with law; that said election was held in accordance with law; and that a one-quarter (1/4) of one percent (1%) sales and use tax for street maintenance was approved.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND AND DETERMINED, that in accordance with the order of this governing body, that the City Secretary posted the written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient to the public; said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the time of this meeting.
