(3 POSITIONS)**

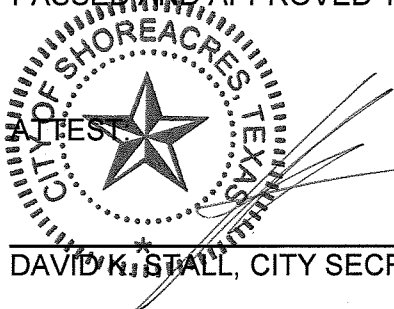
Dana Woodruff	28 votes

THAT, said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given accordance with law; that said election was held in accordance with law; and that **Dana Woodruff, Richard Adams and Connie F. Ramirez were duly elected to council as Alderman-at-Large.** Said named persons are hereby declared duly elected to their offices subject to the taking of oaths of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER FOUND AND DETERMINED, that in accordance with the order of this governing body, that the City Secretary posted the written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient to the public; said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the time of this meeting.
