### RESOLUTION No. 2016-192 CITY OF SHOREACRES

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSLY ALLOWING THE CONCEALED CARRY OF A FIREARM BY A PERSON LICENSED UNDER TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 11, SUBCHAPTER H (HANDGUN LICENSING LAW) INTO THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING ROOM WHEN MEETING ARE BEING HELD BY CITY COUNCIL, BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, Texas Penal Code Section 46.035(c) makes it an offense for a handgun license holder to intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly carry a handgun under the authority of Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code (Handgun Licensing Law), regardless of whether the handgun is concealed or carried in a shoulder or belt holster, in the room or rooms where a meeting of a governmental entity is held and if the meeting is an open meeting subject to Chapter 551, Government Code (Open Meetings Act), and the entity provides notice as required by that chapter; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Penal Code Section 46.035(i) provides that the prohibition in Section 46.035(c) does not apply unless the license holder is given effective notice under Penal Code Sections 30.06 and 30.07 by signage displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the public; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shoreacres affirms the rights of licensed handgun owners to responsibly carry a handgun as authorized under the Texas Government Code, Chapter 411, Subchapter H; and,

WHEREAS, the best interpretation of that conflicting language is to display the signage at the entrance to the meeting room.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, TEXAS:

THAT, the City of Shoreacres expressly allows the concealed carry of a firearm by a person licensed under Chapter 411, Subchapter H (Handgun Licensing Law), into the room or rooms in which any meeting of the city council or any other board or commission that is subject to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code (Open Meetings Act) is held, at which time the room is hereby deemed not to be utilized by the court and therefore not subject to Texas Penal Code Sec. 46.03(a)(3); and,

THAT, city staff is directed to remove signage erected in accordance with Texas Penal Code Sections 30.07.

The City Council officially finds, determines, recites, and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this resolution and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
