We purchased 8.1 million gallons of water in September, compared to 8.2 million gallons August. Water leaks continue to play a big part in our purchase amount.

16 water leaks were repaired this month. 3 of the water leaks this month were caused by conflict with storm construction. On a positive note, all conflicts with our water and sewer infrastructure should be very minimal now as the culverts and ditch work have been completed on this round of work. We should see leaks begin to come back down by the end of September, or early October, as cooler temperatures approach.

ORDINANCE No. 2013-144 ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET FOR FY-2013/2014

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OPERATING BUDGET AND THE CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF SHOREACRES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2013 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2014; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas State Law, the Mayor of the City of Shoreacres as Budget Officer, has prepared and submitted a budget covering the period from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding the proposed Operating Budget and Capital Budget for FY 2013/2014 was published on the City of Shoreacres' Internet website and in the official city newspaper; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding the proposed Operating Budget and Capital Budget for FY 2013/2014 was held on October 14, 2013; and

WHEREAS, notice of this meeting, at which the Budget is to be adopted, has also been given in accordance with State Law; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. BUDGET ADOPTED.

That in the opinion and judgment of the majority of the City of Shoreacres Council Members, as signified by "aye votes," the Proposed Operating Budget and Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2013/2014 as shown on Attachment "A" to this Ordinance is hereby made a part thereto; by and the same is hereby in all things approved and that same is proper and correct.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

The City Council of the City of Shoreacres hereby declares that if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it will not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council declares it would have passed and ordained all the remaining portions of this Ordinance without the inclusion of those portions found to be unconstitutional or invalid.

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-145 CITY OF SHOREACRES

ESTABLISHMENT OF TAX RATE OF \$0.844381 PER \$100 VALUATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013/2014

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATE OF \$0.844381 PER \$100 VALUATION FOR THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2013/2014 COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2013 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2014; AUTHORIZING THE LEVY, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF AD VALORUM TAXES BASED UPON THE ESTABLISHED RATE; DECLARING DISTRIBUTION OF SAID TAX RATE IN THE GENERAL FUND; AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR AND COLLECTOR OF THE CITY OF LA PORTE, TEXAS TO SERVE AS THE TAX ASSESSOR/COLLECTOR OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES, STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The tax rate for the City of Shoreacres, Harris County, Texas for the Fiscal Year 2013/2014 commencing on October 1, 2013 and ending on September 30, 2014 is hereby established at \$0.844381 per \$100 valuation of the taxable property, real, personal, mineral or mixed, situated within the corporate limits of said City of Shoreacres, Harris County, Texas. Such rate is sometimes referred to as \$0.844381 per \$100.00 valuation. Property shall be assessed at 100 per-cent of fair market value.

SECTION 2. The annual levy of the aforesaid tax is herewith authorized and made on all said property that is not expressly exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas. The said levy shall be based upon the aforesaid rate, the valuation of said properties determined by the Harris County Appraisal District and the City of Shoreacres Tax Assessor and Collector and the assessments made pursuant thereto.

SECTION 3. The aforesaid levy shall and does include any and all powers granted by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas for the enforcement of liens created by this levy, the assessment and collection of taxes as well as penalties and interest for delinquency, if any, hereby authorized, and the allocation and distribution of all tax revenue collected.

SECTION 4. The aforesaid tax rate shall be distributed in the City of Shoreacres accounts as follows:

General Fund: 100.00% of said collection.

Tax Sinking Fund: 0.00% of said collection.

SECTION 5. The Tax Assessor and Collector of the City of La Porte, Texas is hereby designated and authorized to act as Tax Collector and Assessor for the City of Shoreacres, with any and all attendant rights, powers and privileges and shall receive the sum of \$4.35 per taxable item for the services performed for and on behalf of the City of Shoreacres.

SECTION 6. Any and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, if any, in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are, thereby expressly repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

SECTION 7. The City Council of the City of Shoreacres hereby declares that if any section, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by final judgement of a court of competent jurisdiction, it will not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council declares that it would have passed and ordained all the remaining portions of this Ordinance without the inclusion of those portions found to be unconstitutional or invalid.

ORDINANCE No. 2013-146 CITY OF SHOREACRES, TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING INTRACOUNTY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

* * * *

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHOREACRES:

That if any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance; and,

That the City Council officially finds, determines, recites, and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ordinance and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

That section 2-38 of the Shoreacres City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-38. Intracounty expense allowance of mayor and councilmen.

- (a) The members of the council shall serve without salary; however, they shall be entitled to reimbursement of expenses incurred in the performance of their official council duties. It is intended that this allowance shall be in lieu of any reimbursement of intracounty mileage for official city business and to assist in defraying nonreimbursable obligations that public office tends to generate.
- (b) The allowance for the mayor of the city shall be thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per month.
- (c) The allowance for each councilman of the city shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per month.
- (d) The reimbursement of any extracounty travel or related expenses for official city business shall not be precluded by this section. This allowance is not intended to be based on any average number of meetings per month or any average volume of work, but is intended to be a constant monthly figure.

(e) This section shall only be in effect during years when the city's fiscal yearly budget is at or below the city's yearly estimated revenues and the actual property tax rate for the city was not raised year over year.

This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval, and it is so ordered.

That the City Council officially finds, determines, recites, and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ordinance and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

That section 66-183 of the Shoreacres City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 66-183. - Water rates.
