#### 7.0 ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

7.1 <u>City Administrator Report</u>: Mr. Stall reported: Early Voting started today and will run until May 6; Election Day is Saturday, May 10. Sound wall update – TxDOT discovered that the city's main sewer line is in the way of where they will be

drilling to install one of the footings for the sound wall; relocation of this main line is very costly to the city; Mr. Stall has asked the City Engineer, Mr. Jerry Gainer to take the lead in addressing the issue with TxDOT and propose alternative solutions. He will meet with TxDOT on Tuesday to discuss further and we are hopeful that a successful resolution can be found.

7.1.1 Water Project updates – We are very close to fully resolving the water pressure issues throughout the city. Water aeration – previously there were discussions of installing a baffle inside the water tank but after further study, it was concluded that this action will not fully correct the problem and it would cost more than originally anticipated. The lead engineer of the project has come up with another solution and has requested a quote from our contractor. The SCADA programming is progressing as expected. With both of the water plants in full operation, we've ordered a hydrant flow test for all of the hydrants in the city and the results are as follows:

In July 2011, we had nineteen hydrants located east of Old Highway 146 that were identified as "Marginal". Today, that number has shrunk to two hydrants with a flow capacity of 500 GPM or less. We will continue striving to improve the water capacity in our systems as we move forward.
