1.0 CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jayo Washington at 7:03 p.m.

2.0 PUBLIC HEARINGS, SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS & COMMENTS

2.1 Citizen's Comments

<u>Suzanne Huvelle, 3422 Miramar</u>: Told council that she had come to observe the meeting.

Gerry Victor, 3436 Miramar: Addressed council to encourage the Mayor to negotiate with the Port of Houston Authority (POHA). He told council that he has noticed that some of the port noise is correctable. Specifically he reported that some ships leave their main engine running creating noise and air pollution. The POHA should restrict the running of main engines or require them to move. Second, he reported some fueling barges are noisy while others are not. He also reported that he will be replacing single strength glass pane aluminum frame windows in two rooms of his house and will report on the noise reduction effectiveness of double pane windows.
