# 4.2.1 City Administrator's Report

<u>David Stall</u>: Reported that an effort is being made to clean up vacant lots; the city has approval to receive up to eight employees (2 clerical & 6 field workers) through a H-GAC emergency grant program; Wednesday night flood workshops are continuing during November and December; the number of visitors to the Mobile Disaster Recovery Center are half what FEMA had hoped; and, several complaints about insurance companies have been filed with the Texas Department of Insurance by Shoreacres homeowners.
