

## POLICE REPORT FOR COUNCIL MEETING 12-12-2011

### SH 146 FLY OVER CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

On Friday, December 2, 2011, I received an email from Duodu Godfried of TXDOT stating the original schedule for closing SH 146 at Port Road for the SB Connector steel girder erection starting in the first week of December, 2011 has been pushed back by the contractor. A new date will be made known after a consultative meeting. We still do intend to give the traveling public a two week advance notice prior to the work starting.

Overpass work at Shoreacres Blvd. and SH 146 for steel girder erection was completed last Saturday 12-3, 2011 in six hours. The crossover from Shoreacres Blvd. to Choate Road was closed during that time. There were no traffic problems.

### REQUIRED STATE OFFICER WEAPON QUALIFICATION

All officers of the Shoreacres Police Department qualified with their on and off duty weapons as mandated by the State of Texas last week.

### NIMS TRAINING UPDATE

Chief French, Sergeant Cantu, and Corporal Manolescu attended the forty hour class at Pearland and completed all NIMS classes required. All officers have completed the required classes and all have created a folder with the Texas Department of Public Safety and downloaded their certificates. Corporal D. Manolescu also created a roster of classes and that roster was sent to Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Education to be applied towards the officers required forty hours of training.

### CODE ENFORCEMENT

Starting this week a new list of all property owners with dangerous dead trees will be created. All property owners not in compliance will receive a letter advising of the violation and what steps they should take.
